



Partners in Policymaking® is a leadership training program that teaches adults with disabilities and the parents of young children with disabilities how to advocate for themselves and others in all settings. Participants are expected to attend five two-day sessions, one weekend per month, and will receive information, training and resources about local, state, and national issues affecting people with disabilities.



Participants are reimbursed for travel to and from Columbia.

Lodging and meals are provided for participants.

***(Lodging provided for those traveling more than 50 miles to class)**

Attendant support and respite reimbursement are provided for those meeting eligibility requirements.
