SCHSPA Webinar Series

September 10, 2024: KICKOFF: How agencies transform their culture to become a Tech 1st Organization using Person Centered practices, policies and transformative thinking.

This is an overview of the Tech 1st/enabling technology movement and practices to include what requirements an agency needs for a Tech 1st culture to include the Introduction of a Technology Toolkit.

October 8, 2024: Introduction to Enabling Technology and Remote Supports

This is an overview of what enabling technology solutions are available to include an introduction to the use of remote supports.

November 12, 2024: Enabling Technology at Home Primer

This will be an introduction of technical devices individuals can have in their homes to promote independence and assist with maintaining their health. The presentation will discuss how having tech in one's home does not mean they have to lose their privacy.
